St. Augustine Christmas Parade Surprise



The 62nd annual St. Augustine Christmas Parade made

St. Augustine Record's Internet Photo its way through the historic district of St. Augustine, Florida on December 2, 2017.

One of the most spectacular entries was the St. Augustine Tea Party's Dartmouth. The original Dartmouth was one of three ships from which tea was thrown into Boston Harbor on December 16, 1775. Later to be known as the Boston Tea Party. It's been four years since the St. Augustine Tea Party (SATP) acquired its replica Dartmouth. The Dartmouth has participated in the last four Christmas parades in St. Augustine. The St. Augustine Record, a local print media known for its radical Marxist bias, provides an online pictorial review of each entry in the parade. Often obscure entries are pictured. But The Record has always chosen to leave out

one of the most substantial floats, year after year. For comparison, SAFD's hook and ladder number 47, which carried Santa Claus in this year's parade, is about the same size as the Dartmouth.

The Dartmouth has a proud history. During her eight years existence, She has been to Washington, DC and has had governors, senators and congressmen speak from her decks.

The Record continues to avoid publishing a picture of the Dartmouth, but this year has seen fit to

"I was really surprised that they included a picture of our marching group. They were marching in front of the tow vehicle for the Dartmouth. The Public Chooses Patriots

Striking Contrast between Nights of Lights Protesters

In the wake of the riots in Charlottesville, Virginia, a community organizer from Gainesville; Rev. Ronald Rawls applied intimidation, racism and hatred as a means to destroy St. Augustine's Confederate monuments.

Ron Rawls' intimidation at his organizational meeting on August 21, assured a fast-track to be included on the agenda of August 28, 2017 City Commissioners meeting. Mayor Nancy Shaver, Vice Mayor Todd Neville and City Manager John Regan were present at the AME Church meeting. If it had not been for a petition, which ran 10 to 1 in favor of retention, the "Social Justice" sentiment in the City Commission would have joined in the national Confederate statue hysteria. Over 11,000 petition signatures have now been obtained by one determined young lady, Jill Pacetti. The community organizer, Rawls, was defeated at the October 23 City Commissioners meeting. He then vowed to take his hate to the "Nights of Lights" light up celebration on November 18, 2017.

It is now clear that the "Social Justice" people at City Hall accommodated his efforts. On November 14, the Mayor made an appearance at the Tea Party's open meeting. She requested that the Tea Party stand down for the sake of public safety. The Mayor was informed that the Tea Party would not stand down and they would be present at the Confederate monument. The original Rawls marching plans from the church to the monument were altered. It appears that the Mayor provided a red carpet to the bandstand where live Christmas music was played. The St. Augustine Record was there to take pictures which appeared on the front page the next day. Mayor Shaver reported that 163 protesters were present with 100 being bused in from other cities. Videotape taken by the 3%ers militia revealed an exact count of 63 people. An interesting play on numbers. The majority of people protesting where made up with white people championing a variety of communist issues. One blackface among the demonstrators was that of James Evans Mohammed, a high-ranking official of the New Black Panther Party, with experience in the riots in Ferguson, Missouri. Given the potential for Black Lives Matter and Antifa, the "Social Justice Kings" at City Hall showed little interest in public safety.

The demonstrators were booed by the public. The dissatisfaction of the public with the protesters was so harsh that their activities terminated early. A spokesman for the 3%ers claimed that their militia numbers exceeded the protester numbers. Most of their people were in ordinary dress and blended in with the general public. Those that were not covert enjoyed the cheers of the public with their newly found Tea Party friends.

The Contrast between the Rawls' protesters and the "Parade Patriots" could not be clearer. Rawls had no support from the public for his radical communist agenda. His effort convinced no one. Even the Fake News

coverage in the Record is no longer believed by the populist majority. He was booed off the stage, so to speak. The Parade Patriots had no need to convince anyone because they are already connected to the public. The Tea Party and the Three Percent were cheered on.

The 3%ers were present when they were needed in the Plaza on August 28 and they were present at the Nights of Lights on November 18.

"New faces are among the sea of faces that make up the populist movement which will save the country from the communist transformation. A transformation now being attempted. Our Tea Party is grateful that these patriots have our backs covered. They will play a big part in the defeat of the progressive style of communism," Lance Thate, SATP Chairman stated.

A VOTER REFERENDUM ON MUNN PARK WAR MEMORIAL

DUNN'S VICTORY AN UPSET: Coalition Declares Victory

Lakeland - Yesterday's landslide win for City Commissioner, Mike Dunn, should signal to all political hopefuls that debasing the Munn Park War Memorial would be political suicide at the ballot box.

"Michael Dunn's victory is proof positive that the folks in Lakeland want to keep the Munn Park Memorial," said David McCallister, Save Southern Heritage Florida (SSH FL) spokesman. "We view this as a public referendum on the issue. It should send a resounding message to those who hope to seek re-election in the future that there should be re-consideration of Monday's 4-3 surprise vote to take down the Munn Park v

Veterans' Memorial."

Dunn, himself a veteran who had previously run unsuccessfully for Commissioner, campaigned openly for keeping the historic Veterans Memorial in place.

Dunn will replace incumbent Commissioner Don Selvege, who led Monday's sneak attack on the Memorial.

The War Memorial became a key issue in the City Commission campaign, despite Commissioner Selvege's bulldoggish surprise move Monday that resulted in the vote that left Commissioner Yates feeling "sandbagged".

Despite over 6,000 letters, emails and phone calls, just slightly less than the number of voters in Tuesday's election, the Commission ignored the will of the people, after threats and intimidation from anti-veteran memorial groups.

"We were worried about this happening, so our coalition members took a key interest in the campaign. Save Southern Heritage conducted an extensive voter education campaign," said McCallister.

Save Their Honor Political Committee conducted its own campaign on behalf of Dunn with the Munn Park Memorial as the call to action in the election. Local citizen activists seeking to "Save the Statue ("STS") worked vigorously to spread the word that Dunn was pro-Veterans Memorial.

"We believe the coalition, STS, SSH FL and Save Their Honor, and the rest 'moved the needle' Tuesday."

Two other recent elections were wins for pro-Veterans Memorial candidates. Lakeland's Commissioner Malless lost his re-election bid last month, and Lawrence McClure won the Republican primary in a special election for Florida House District 58 on a pro-Memorial platform.

"We will be announcing a new campaign soon to expand on Dunn's victory and Malless' removal made possible by the voters in Lakeland," McCallister said. "Selvege's legacy to Lakeland is discord and division; we believe the new Commissioner won't let that stand".

"Our poll showed that most Lakelanders feel it is blasphemous to even be discussing removing a memorial to dead veterans," said McCallister. "We expect the new Commission to put the process in hard reverse when they take office in January," McCallister concluded.

SAVE SOUTHERN HERITAGE, Inc. is a not for profit education and advocacy organization for Southern Heritage & History. It was started in 2015 in response to the knee-jerk Anti-Southern institutionalized bullying and "Erase-ism" levied against the people of South Carolina by Governor Nikki Haley, after she broke all previous agreements about how South Carolina's historical veterans and their symbols should be treated and respected.

Once again, We the People find ourselves immersed in times that try men's souls.





the war on Southern heritage is not. The guest speaker at the St. Augustine Tea Party's open meeting on December 12, 2017, was the Executive Director of Saving Southern Heritage, Florida (SSHF). Lunelle McCallister travelled from the organization's headquarters in Tampa to address Tea Party members and visitors here. [The Tea Party meets on the 2nd and 4th Tuesday of each month at the Village Inn in St Augustine, Fl Ed]

The attack on the Confederate statues and Veteran's War Monuments started, in earnest after the riots in Charlottesville, Virginia this year. But the initial attack on Confederate symbols started with Republican Governor Nikki Haley's removal of the Confederate "Battle Flag" from State Capital grounds in South Carolina in 2015. That is when the "Saving Southern Heritage" (SSH) organization was founded. The Florida chapter of SSH started about a year later.

Mrs. McCallister exposed the magnitude of Confederate monuments and statues that have been removed across the country. Those in attendance were shocked by the number of photographs that were presented. There were pictures of monuments, being removed at night so as to avoid public notice. There are also pictures of monuments that had been vandalized with either red or black paint. The red being the symbolic color of the Communists and the black the symbolic color of the Anarchists. Vandalism sets up a target for removal according to

Mrs. McCallister. The SSHF has been involved in trying to save Confederate monuments in Lakeland, Tampa, Jacksonville and in St. Augustine, to name a few.

Tea Party Chairman, Lance Thate, pointed out in his report that the Progressive style of Communism is an incremental transformation to Communism from governmental officials and

others top down. As opposed to Marx's original concept of a violent worker's revolution from the bottom up. Violent revolutions have occurred in the USSR, China, Cuba and elsewhere. In this country, Communists hide

The names of the soldiers, both white and black, are inscribed on the monument. The Communists are not interested in monuments. They are interested in furthering their agenda of rewriting history.

It is now clear that the "Social Justice" people at City Hall accommodated Rawls' efforts. Mayor Nancy Shaver provided a red carpet to the bandstand where live Christmas music was being played. The St. Augustine Police Department provided an escort to the center of the "Nights of Lights" celebration.

It was the general consensus at the meeting that the "Social Justice" City Commissioners would have joined in the national Confederate statue hysteria and voted for removal; if it had not been for a petition, which ran 10 to 1 in favor of retaining the monuments. Over 11,000 petition signatures have now been obtained by one determined young lady, Jill Pacetti. The Pacetti family name is on the monument. Jill Pacetti attended Tuesday's Tea Party meeting.

The Tea Party's Town Criers have made several appearances at the monuments in St. Augustine. Their purpose was to promote a public awareness to the need of preserving our Southern and American history. On several occasions, they were joined by a militia group known as the "3 Percent". The group is so named because during the revolutionary war only 3% of the population actually engaged in hostilities on the battlefield. Chairman Thate reports that an alliance between the Three Percent group in Jacksonville and the Tea Party has been formed. "It's good to know that you have your back covered by patriots as enthusiastic as these people are," the Chairman said. There was a militia presence at Tuesday's meeting.

Lunelle McCallister made an impassioned plea for people to join together to save our Southern and American history. It appears that she was successful. A sizable number of Tea Party people chose to support her organization by becoming members. Everyone in the room understood that if we allow these Communist agitators to destroy our monuments and symbols, American Liberty will be permanently lost.

The public, since the riots in Charlottesville, has awakened to the need to preserve our heritage. But being aware is not enough, they will need to stand up and face the enemy. Public involvement in the City Halls across the nation, must take place. We so outnumber this Communist minority that, they are hardly worth recognizing. But we must because governmental units at all levels are working for a transformation to a Communist state.

It is ironic that to save American history, it is essential to save the Confederate history. The founding principles of our Constitution reside in the notion of a Confederacy. The concept of "Sovereign States" and "Federalism"

which is imbedded in the 10th Amendment is the bedrock of our Constitutional principles. It is exactly the alienation of these principles that brought forth the struggle known as the "War between the States". Long live the Confederacy, so that American history can survive, was the sentiment expressed in the room.

By air time the next day, the pundits on Fox News' show, "The Five", were declaring the GOP loss as a victory. The party would be saved from the embarrassment of

this extreme, perhaps, perverted man. Republican media outlets across the board were offering a sigh of relief. True to Republican form, they rushed to the call for 'concession'. 

Fake News Exposed

Latest Home Town Example

As the old year draws to a close and the new year approaches, it is only natural that we reflect on the continuum of our past efforts and

contemplate the new course for the coming year.



So it is with this publication. Our first issue was only an attempt to convince interested parties that the Tea Party had survived the attempted Republican coup in 2011. Instantly, however, we were thrown into the "Occupy St. Augustine" demonstrations. We saw a need to provide an alternative to both local and national media coverage as a result. The term "Fake News" had not been coined

FB Image back then; the phenomenon, however, was clearly present. No one was more despised, by the media, than the Tea Party movement that gave rise to the populist groundswell that elected Donald Trump as President.

As a result, the Tea Party movement has been under a continual barrage of dis-information by the media. This publication, The Town Crier Committee Report (TCCR) has extensive experience in disclosing the techniques and exposing the presence of media distortion. This is because of the TCCR's extensive reporting on Tea Party activities. When you are the focus of their corrupt reporting, it is easy to discern their techniques.

Since the Charlottesville, Virginia riots in August 2017, two Veteran Memorials located in the historic district of St. Augustine, Florida have been under attack by elements of the radical left. The Veteran Memorials honor the Confederate war dead. The City Commissioners listened to arguments on both sides at two of their regular Commissioner's meetings. There was a great deal of support among the "Social Justice Warriors", on the Commission, for the removal of the Veteran Memorials. But in the face of overwhelming support for the retention of the monuments, the Commissioners voted 5 to 0 to save the monuments. For the Communist left, this was not acceptable.

True to form, the St. Augustine Record, a local newspaper, has promoted their ongoing activities. The principal feature was the "Nights of Lights" protest demonstration. They provided the Communist left with front page coverage, making their march through the streets the focal point of the "Nights of Lights" celebration. The reality of the situation was that the vast majority in attendance, perhaps as many as 8000, counting the overflow crowd in the streets, were totally unaware of the activities of 63 predominantly white activists bused in from Gainesville and Jacksonville. It doesn't matter whether the "Fake News" occurs in the New York Times, the Washington Post or the St. Augustine Record. The methods to deceive and to promote the Progressive's

incremental Communist agenda are always the same. And now, the drum beat of the Progressive Communist agenda continues.

A recent example is an article entitled; <u>St. Augustine's Confederate monument holds very different meanings for two local women</u> by Sheldon Gardner. The article was published by the St. Augustine Record on December 24, 2017. http://staugustine.com/news/local-news/2017-12-24/st-augustine-s-confederate-monument-holds-very-different-meanings-two

In this human interest article, published on Christmas Eve, the story of two women representing differing perspectives is presented in what appears to be a fair and balanced manner. It would have been fair and balanced had Sheldon Gardner, or her Editors, not shamefully excluded relevant facts.

Jill Pacetti was described as a local woman who engaged in the monument controversy because her family name is inscribed on the monument and because of her belief that the preservation of history in a diverse historical city is essential. Jill Pacetti has contacted TCCR and confirmed that she believes the article is a fair representation as it pertains to her. The Record even reported the fact that Pacetti conducted a petition to gage the public's view regarding the monuments. They reported, "She opened a petition to keep the monument, which received thousands of signatures, and she presented it to the city." The Record has a long history of expanding the numbers for the radical left and understating the numbers for those that they do not support. The language "thousands of signatures" is an effort to understate the true number. As of December 24, 2017, the actual number of people signing the petition was 11,649. Pacetti's petition continues to attract signatures.

The Record's interview with Jamie Perkins goes like this; Perkins, working as an 18-year old bank teller, encounters a man who verbally abused her along racial lines. It turns out that he was wearing a Confederate lapel pin. As a result of this incident, Perkins has been uncomfortable going to the Plaza because of the Confederate monuments. The Record's interview with Jamie Perkins portrays a traumatized woman now nearing her mid-30s. She believes herself to be a victim of racism in St. Augustine and sees America as racist as well.

This human interest story of two impassioned women on opposite sides of the issue is designed to reopen the case for monument removal. In the spirit of Christmas and Christian charity, The Record hopes to motivate the people to the Communist cause. We say Communist cause, because this human interest farce wouldn't motivate a single soul in the great majority if the true identity of Jamie Perkins had been reported.

The St. Augustine Record has a history of quoting extreme radical leftists without identifying them. Jamie Perkins is a radical left wing political activist. She has been associated with the Women's March, Community Organizer Ron Rawls' Black Lives Matter people and as an organizer for Bernie Sander, who is a self professed Communist.

We find it interesting that The Record is so captivated by the Confederate lapel pin story that they have seen fit to publish the quote on at least two occasions. The most recent was on Christmas Eve. The media loses when a quote slips into a "talking points" quote. This is especially true if you're trying to win public sympathy.

On August 29, 2017, The Record quoted Perkins, almost verbatim, regarding her public comments at the City of St. Augustine Commission meeting on August 28. Her statements about slavery, racism and the Ku Klux Klan marching around St. Augustine lose standing when her statements are compared to Communist "talking points" used around the Country. The last time the KKK marched in St. Augustine, Jamie was in the process of being born.

Lunelle McCallister, the Executive Director of Save Southern Heritage, cautioned the members of the St. Augustine Tea Party, at their December 12th meeting, that the monument issue here is not over. Based on The Record's attempt to reignite the conversation, it is clear McCallister was right in her assessment.

So as we look down the road leading to 2018 and contemplate the New Year's course, this publication sees a renewed dedication to exposing "Political Correctness" and "Fake News". The TCCR reminds its foes:

- Political Correctness has no place in our world.
- And remember, we enjoy offending people with the truth.
