The St. Augustine Tea Party celebrated Independence Day for the fifth straight year at the Castillo de San Marcos.

"The Fort", as it is known locally, is located in the historic district of St. Augustine, Florida.

Six years ago, the Tea Party was instrumental in extending First

Amendment rights across the entire park grounds at this National Park. Prior to their involvement, a free speech zone had been established confining the First Amendment activity to a very limited space. Today all Americans can celebrate their constitutional right to assemble and speak at the Castillo de San Marcos.

The St. Augustine celebration of the Fourth of July attracts an estimate of upward to 60,000 people. The National Park Service estimates that 15,000 people are located on their grounds alone during the fireworks at the conclusion of the day's festivities.

St. Augustine Tea Party volunteers arrived at 7 AM with their replica of the Dartmouth. The original Dartmouth was one of three ships from which tea was thrown into Boston Harbor in 1773. The event in Boston is considered a major protest that led to Concord and Lexington two years later and the beginning of the American Revolution in 1775. The signing of the Declaration of Independence on July 4, 1776 continues to excite patriots across the country. The Tea Party's boat was parked so that it was seen by the traffic on the Bayfront, by every trolley train dispatched during the day as they passed directly in front of the Dartmouth and it was also seen by anyone entering the Fort grounds. It was impossible not to see the impressive 38 foot Dartmouth with its expansive banner and flags.

Because of the extreme traffic caused by the celebrations of the day, Tea Party volunteers rarely get home before midnight. According to the Tea Party, the effort is well worthwhile; they meet patriots both local and from across America.

This year, to gauge the popularity of President Trump, a full sized photo was attached to the side of the boat. The public enthusiastically responded by taking pictures of themselves with the picture of the President.

Adjacent to the
Dartmouth, the Tea
Party maintained a tent
and under it, a table
from which they

dispensed the Heritage Foundation's pocket editions of the Constitution and the Declaration of Independence to the public. They also provided drinking water. Small American flags, Gadsden flags and "Don't Tread on Me" bracelets were distributed to the children and adults alike.

### Rawls **Targets Tea** Party's **Dartmouth**

Community organizer, Ron Rawls, has staged a series of demonstrations in the

historic district of St. Augustine, Florida. His initial demonstration was an attempt to disrupt the "Nights of Lights" opening celebration of the Christmas season. His signage tended to reflect the local Monument issue and a variety of Communist agenda items. According to Mayor Shaver, 163 individuals participated. The 3% Militia videotape count reveals that the actual number was 63. The vast numbers of people in attendance on that night, about 8000, were totally unaware of Rawls' effort to have our monuments removed. City officials and the local print media, however, played up the event creating an artificial importance. Rawls' second effort, designed to disrupt the City Commissioners meeting on January 22, 2018, failed to accomplish its goal because of police action. Television coverage from Jacksonville helped save the day for him, though his numbers had dwindled substantially.

Unable to attract even token local support, Rawls turned to his Communist allies in Jacksonville and enlisted the OccupyJax.Com organization, BLM and others. Attacks on St. George Street, the main tourist business artery, took place on March 10, April 7 and May 19 of 2018. The May 19<sup>th</sup> event was actually a three day planned March from Jacksonville to St. Augustine. The "Selma Style March" was a complete farce with only seven marchers

completing the trip. Progressive officials within the "City Government" gave aid to the Rawls' effort. The St. Augustine Police Department (SAPD), by failing to enforce existing laws and by cordoning off the Tea Party and their allies, gave free reign to the Jacksonville Communists. Rawls and his communist demonstrators owned the streets in the historic district for a couple hours.

These three events were not covered by the media and were rejected by the public. So Rawls changed his Occupy image to a "Liberation Theology" stance. Liberation Theology is a Communist interpretation of Christianity. The current Pope is a product of that philosophy.

Priestly Attire with the Communist Salute

Ron Rawls is a Community Organizer from Gainesville, Fl. He is also a pastor at the St. Paul's African Methodist Episcopal Church (AME) in St. Augustine. Methodist pastors rarely, if ever, wear the "Priestly Collar" according to several Methodist sources. We know, however, that on the AME website some AME Bishops wear the "Collar". Perhaps Ron Rawls has promoted

himself as he was wearing the "Priestly Collar" during the demonstration on the 4th of July, 2018. His small group of 27, once again, carried more locally appropriate signage and invoked images of Dr. Martin Luther King. It was an insult to Dr. King's memory, according to those old enough to remember his demonstrations. King's speaking the truth was his sword. Propagating the "Communist Lie" is Rawls' weapon and Saul Alinsky's 'Rules for Radical's' is his Bible.

The 3% Militia were able to get past the SAPD as part of the crowd, reported that they challenged Rawls in the Plaza and flanked him as he made his march up the Bayfront. Perhaps the Dartmouth float at the south entrance to the Fort was simply a target of opportunity or perhaps it was planned. However, Rawls never proceeded beyond the Dartmouth, which was located on Federal land. The SAPD was present on the grounds, but Federal Park Rangers determined policy.



## Tea Party and the Public Humiliate Rawls' Effort

As Rawls approached the Dartmouth, the prospect of engaging as many as 15,000 people was a possibility. Rawls and his bunch stood within 20 feet of the rail and deck of the Dartmouth. They began their chants of racist slurs and references to Trump and the KKK. "It mattered not that the SATP has had the honor of having numerous Black Speakers featured at our meetings. The hate filled nonsense began," Lance Thate SATP Chairman said.

The public picked up on the 'USA, USA, USA' and the roar of the USA chant completely drowned out the racist content of the Rawls' group. Though they were within 20 feet, all that was heard was 'USA, USA'. How many of the 15,000 people picked up on the USA chant was impossible to determine by those on board the Dartmouth. The sound was devastating to Rawls. The "Community Organizer" turned Priest turned tail and departed. The Progressives in St. Augustine's City Government could not protect him on Federal property.

## City Commissioners July 9<sup>th</sup> Meeting



### Lots of Push Back by Citizens

The City of St. Augustine Commissioners held their regular monthly meeting on July 9, 2018. On the agenda was the Contextualization issue.

There were a considerable number of citizens in attendance to express their dissatisfaction with the Contextualization Report and with the Commissioner's closing their eyes to the general lawlessness associated with Community Organizer, Ron Rawls. The public comment speakers reflected their dissatisfaction with the board by 3 to 1 regarding these issues.

The first public comment speaker was Tea Party Chairmen, Lance Thate. He addressed the shameful behavior of the Police on May 19. However, Thate held the Board, not Chief Fox or the Police officers, responsible for the lawlessness. The Police Chief is not an elected official. He is an employee and he follows the dictates of the City Commissioners. Others joined in on the issue.

The majority of people were there to oppose the concept of adding plaques changing the history of the Confederate Veteran's Memorial. Many found the concept of "White Supremacy", as stated in the report and proposed on plaques, to be extremely offensive.

It seems clear to this reporter that the decision to accept the Contextualization Report and to proceed was a foregone conclusion. No credence was given to the public's comments. The Contextualization Committee Report was approved by a 4 to 1 vote. Mayor Shaver was the only dissenting vote. # A Sixty Year Celebration





## **New Poll Shows** Trump's Base is **Rock Solid**




