# When the Reckonings Come Due

Reckoning is mostly an accountant's term for counting and computing, eventually leading to a statement of a sum due. When your Applebee's waitress brings you the bill (the reckoning) at the end of your meal, you pay on your way out, and you voluntarily settle the account.

In a courtroom, when you stand guilty before the judge, he hands you the 'bill', the reckoning, of the damage for which you shall be held accountable. The judge is the accountant here, and your sentence is meant to settle your 'bill'. You will settle it, even if involuntarily.

There are small reckonings, and larger ones, historical reckonings. In 1517, Martin Luther nailed "Ninety-Five Theses" to a Catholic Chapel Door in Wittenberg, Germany. Martin Luther began the reckoning, the settlement of accounts, against a corrupt Catholic Church, and the Protestant Reformation was born.

In 1620, English citizens sailed to America to escape religious persecution, thus beginning the reckoning that Thomas Jefferson would so eloquently record 150 years later in the Declaration of Independence. The

Revolutionary War ended King George's tyrannical rule, and the Pilgrims' reckoning, at long last, was achieved. The United States would become a sovereign nation.

But the Founders made a critical mistake at The Constitutional Convention of 1787. After 7 long years of war for their own freedom and liberty, the states were unable to agree on the subject of slavery. So, the scourge of slavery would continue in the newly-free, now United States. Hoping for the best, the Founders kicked this dangerous can down the road.

A reckoning for continued slavery would come in 1861 with the Civil War. And what a painful reckoning it was....nearly 620,000 dead Americans in the most deadly war America has ever fought. But slavery in America was ended.

# New St. George Street Poll Results

## Who is Better for the Country?

While the US Senate was busy confirming Kavanaugh for the Supreme Court, the Town Crier's pollsters were busy conducting their "St. George Street Poll" in the historic district of St. Augustine, Florida. The poll question was, "Who is better for the country, Republicans, Democrats or Trump?" The public's response was as follows:

The Town Criers, a Committee of the St. Augustine Tea Party, have been assessing the public's opinion in the historic district of St. Augustine since early 2011. The historic district is frequented by visitors from across the country and is national in scope. The demographics of the area have permitted the Town Criers to make accurate political predictions.

For example, based on the public's responses, the Town Criers were able to predict, in January 2012, that Mitt Romney would win the Republican nomination for President, but would fail in the national general election.

The first formal St. George Street poll was conducted on January 31, 2015. The Town Criers had observed that the establishment polls varied considerably with the public's response on St. George Street. As a test, discredited Sarah Palin was run against Hillary Clinton with the question, "Who would you prefer for President?" The poll results were: Sarah Palin, 74%, Hillary Clinton, 6% and neither, 20%. The poll was run again on April 18, 2015, after Clinton announced she was a candidate for president. The results were: 79% for Palin, 7% for Clinton and 14% for neither.

When Donald Trump announced that he was running for President, the Town Criers conducted polls running Trump against Bush, Marco Rubio, Ben Carson and Ted Cruz. Trump always outperformed the other Republican hopefuls by a considerable margin. For example, on November 11, 2015, it was Trump, 50%, Ben Carson, 38%, Jeb Bush, 9%, with 3% preferring none of the listed candidates. The Town Criers also ran Trump against Hillary Clinton and others.

On February 27, 2016, Trump polled 57%, Clinton, 21% and neither, 22%. Based on the polling, the Town Criers were able to predict, accurately, that Donald Trump would be President of the United States and it didn't matter whether the Republicans nominated him or not.

The St. George Street polls are a face-to-face, random selection. Polls are conducted in a national demographic.

Our latest poll indicates that the public has lost confidence in both political parties and, to a large degree, the politicians who make up the leadership of the two parties. It should be remembered that those polled were not aware of the Kavanaugh vote taking place in the Senate as we did our poll. And they were certainly not aware of his confirmation. So, this is a good pre-confirmation vote.

There were people who would not vote for a Republican or Trump because they were Democrats. But they could not vote Democrat either, because they did not believe that their party would be good for the country. There were also couples who would split their votes between Republican and Trump. It was interesting that often the man voted Republican and the woman voted Trump. It should also be noted that many people refused to participate on any level. This occurrence makes this poll somewhat unique.

This poll, like many of the polls we took during the presidential campaign, showed Trump to be the dominant figure. The Town Criers are planning to take the same poll again in about a week to assess the Kavanaugh confirmation.

# DeSantis Opposes Common Core

Ron DeSantis is the first candidate seeking statewide office in Florida who is against common core. Having Ron DeSantis, as our Governor, is probably the only way we can finally stop common core in Florida. Other than, to oppose the sale of common core aligned textbooks

One reason we still have common core is to flunk third graders if they fail on one of the, end of year, Florida State Assessments (FSA). I suppose, traumatizing every third grader, as a failure, for messing up on one test may help pad the State's statistics later on; but how accountable can a little third grader actually be?

The other we reason Florida holds onto common core is to provide the assessment data, to the teacher evaluation algorithm called the Value Added Model (or Method) commonly called VAM. The VAM is accountability on autopilot, which can fire teachers and close schools if the VAM finds them less compliant to the common core standards than their peers.

If you are a teacher, you probably have an opinion on common core, high stakes testing, and the VAM. There are so many studies that have raised important questions about the validity of test-based evaluation and the value-added model. Teachers unions, including the Florida Education Association, (FEA) have pointed out the problems with the VAM. As a teacher, you, no doubt, could point out your own issues with having your career depend on the results of two tests every year. In 2018, the situation, in Florida, is that no one is permitted to even raise the question of the VAM's validity, let alone removing it.

This brings me to the reason I support Ron DeSantis because he said he wants to get rid of what does not work in our education system. Of all the candidates that ran for Governor, Ron DeSantis had the highest rating from the Stop Common Core Coalition of Florida, with an A. His opponent, Andrew Gillum earned a D.

As governor, Ron DeSantis gives us the best chance to make changes, up to and including, getting rid of the entire common core system. This includes the high stake assessments and the VAM teacher evaluations. Over

the years, DeSantis has repeatedly expressed his belief in local control over education, parental involvement in education and autonomy for teachers.

DeSantis is uniquely qualified to break up the good Ol' Boy, crony, network that has been under the thumb of Jeb Bush for over two decades. When DeSantis beat Putnam, it signaled an end to Jeb Bush's control over Florida's education. In addition, with funding from Bill Gates into Jeb's foundations drying up, so too will their influence over Florida's education.

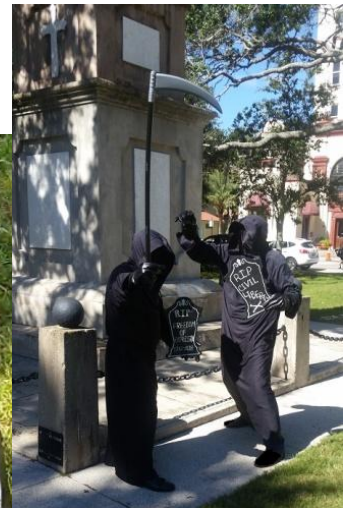
