

Young Republicans

The "Young Republicans" were the guests of the Saint Augustine Tea Party (SATP) on Nov 12, 2019. Cameron Coward, President of the Young Republicans in St, Johns County, was the featured speaker. He gave an impressive rundown of the "Get out the Vote" plans for door-to-door campaigning, particularly in the northern part of the

county where so many new residents have moved in over the last couple of years. Coward spoke to a fully packed group in the side room of the Mello Mushroom Restaurant in St. Augustine, Florida.

Lance Thate, Chairman of the St Augustine Tea Party, opened up the meeting sitting under a giant fish with members in rapt attention to his anti-communist presentation; remembering the Democratic Convention in Chicago in 1968, when he first heard the Communist activists screaming "Pigs!" at the police. He told the



Today the people no longer have representation in Congress. The politicians bear their allegiance to the bureaucracy we now recognize as the Deep State.

Currently, it is the Deep State that prepares the budget, if a budget is actually created at all, and our politician's rubberstamp tax payer exposure to ever expanding spending and borrowing.

Our currency is no longer money as defined in the Constitution.

I'm concerned that on January 21, 2021, the day the winner of the 2020 election will be sworn in, the people who were involved in the struggle that started in Chicago in 1968 will demand a conclusion. During the demonstrations outside the Democratic National Convention in 1968, I witnessed, for the first time in my life, attacks on police officers. The "Baby Boomer Radicals" referred to the officers as 'pigs'. It was the first time I had ever heard that term directed toward our Law Enforcement.

are now older people who are in positions of power and influence. They put in the time and they believe they have a right to rule.



The 26th Annual 'Nights of Lights" celebration in the historic district of St. Augustine, Florida starts with a light up ceremony which, this year, occurred on November 23, 2019. With the flick of a switch, 3 million lights illuminate every corner of the historic district. The lights will remain on until February. It brings joy to the people during the Christmas holidays and winter season. The picturesque city becomes magical for young and old alike. The Nights of Lights has become an international event, with visitors from all over the world, in addition to local residents attending the light up observance. Thousands of people showed up at the Plaza de la Constitucion for the annual light up gala. Perhaps as many as 8000 people reveled in the excitement of the evening. Christmas music and good cheer prevailed across the historic plaza. The event was a huge success.

However, there is a dark side to the affair. Political forces, allied with the Communists, have used the popularity of the event to sow seeds of hate and to further their Marxist agenda, as far back as 2011, by trying to disrupt the festive celebration with the "Occupy St. Augustine" group. Ed Slavin, a local Marxist radical, was a key figure in participating and organizing their activities. Mr. Slavin has filed as a candidate for Supervisor of

Elections. The Soviet leader, Vladimir Lenin, once observed that it is not who votes that determines elections, but it is who counts the votes that does. One can only wonder how it would work out for the people of St. Johns County to have Communists supervising our elections. We may find out if we're not careful!

More recently, the Communists renewed their activities using Occupier and Black Lives Matter forces from Jacksonville to attempt to disrupt the "Nights of Lights" festivities. The primary organizer is Ron Rawls.

Attempts at Disruption Fail

Police Continue their Collaboration with the Radical Left

The clearest evidence that the Radicals failed to accomplish their disruption is the complete lack of coverage of the "Nights of Lights" in the Pravda styled St Augustine Record Newspaper; the local print media in St Augustine. The Record's past coverage of Rawls' demonstrations were flattering front page stories that completely misrepresented the effect on the thousands of people celebrating the beginning of the Christmas season.

In the past, the Communists, led by Ron Rawls with his ever present Communist closed fist salute displayed, has had the cooperation of the St. Augustine Police Department. The Nights of Lights 2019 event was no exception. About 45 minutes before Rawls and his demonstrators made their appearance in the Plaza area, police officers started clearing the sidewalks demanding that the citizens remove themselves from the public right-of-way.

When Rawls finally made his appearance, he had a police escort and was followed by 18 demonstrators. It is safe to say that there were more than 18 police officers involved in their collaboration with Rawls. It should be noted that the Chief of Police is not an elected position. The police do not answer to the people. The Chief is an 'employee' under the control of the City Manager. The current City Manager of the City of St. Augustine, Florida is John Regan.

Mr. Reagan has shown support for the issues that bring Rawls to the streets.

As the demonstration progressed, the police lost control of the sidewalks with the public resuming their rightful use of the sidewalks. When Rawls got close to the bandstand he stopped. The result was a blockage of

pedestrian flow; a clear violation of the law governing public demonstrations. Tea party members began making demands on the police to force Rawls to move and comply with the same rules that are applied to the

Town Crier members when they are on the streets.

This resulted in the police becoming increasingly hostile towards the Tea Party, while Rawls flagrantly violated the law. Police started ordering Tea Party members to leave. At one point a Town Crier came close to being arrested. All this was occurring while Rawls, in his priestly robe and collar, behaved as he pleased. Rawls' demeanor clearly reflected a deep seated hatred and resentment towards the people he encountered. The picture to the left depicts Rawls in a racist screaming match with a Nights of Lights attendee. The hate in his eyes created a "Bug Eye" appearance.

The issue that Rawls alleges as the reason for his demonstrations is to promote the removal of Confederate

Veteran Memorials. Mr. Rawls considers the Veteran Memorials symbols of white supremacy. Earlier in the evening, Tea Party Chairman, Lance Thate, noticed people sitting on the base of the City's Confederate Monument. There is a chain surrounding the monument to protect it. People supportive of retaining the monuments have often been ordered out of the area inside the chain by the St. Augustine Police Department. "I have been ordered out when I went inside the chained area to get a better photograph," Thate revealed. The picture on the right depicts the monument on the Nights of Lights light up. Thate was concerned about people sitting on the base of the monument. It is



disrespectful to the veterans it honors and is an example of on unequal application

of the law. Thate claims that he brought it to the attention of Police Chief Fox, who assured him that he would
remedy the situation. According to Tea Party sources, no remedy or action was ever taken.

The Tea Party Chairman Thate concluded his interview with:

"It must be difficult to be a communist demonstrating in the streets because you are always rejected. Your only hope is to make a nuisance of yourself so you can get press coverage. Tonight, Rawls made a nuisance of himself and he was rejected by the public but he received no press the following day. He had too few numbers to be effective. So his effort came to nothing. On the other hand, our Tea Party presence sporting red 'Make America Great Again' hats were well received. We had no push back whatsoever, not even from the Rawls group. Maybe they secretly like Trump. There are reports of massive defections in the black community to the Trump train. We had a great and successful evening. God bless the Republic."
